

Immunization Clinics

Public Health Immunization Clinics provide immunizations to county residents who do not have health insurance or whose insurance does not cover immunizations. These clinics are not meant to replace well-child checkups or annual exams by healthcare providers.

Carver County Public Health participates in the Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC) program, which provides free vaccines for infants six weeks of age and older and children through 18 years of age who do not have insurance coverage for shots. Adults may also be eligible to receive immunizations through the MnVFC program. For more information, or to determine your eligibility, call 952-361-1329.

- **Appointments:** Immunizations will be given by appointment during clinic hours.
- **Records:** Bring an up-to-date record of all past immunizations.
- **Permission Forms:** Shots cannot be given to children under age 18 unless parents or guardians have signed a permission form for their child to receive shots.
- **Cost:**
 - There is a \$14 fee for the administration of each MnVFC vaccine. However, those who qualify for MnVFC will not be denied immunizations if they are unable to pay this fee.
 - Individuals may pay for vaccines if they are not eligible for the MnVFC program. Public Health cannot bill insurance or Medical Assistance. Shots must be paid for the day they are given. Call 952-361-1329 for details on the cost of receiving vaccine.
- **Interpreter services:** Call Public Health at 952-361-1329 at least two days prior to your appointment to request interpreter services.

Immunizations Provided by the MnVFC Program:

- All required vaccines for enrollment in childcare, Headstart and school.
- All other vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices including Hepatitis A, Human Papillomavirus (HPV), Meningococcal, Rotavirus and Influenza.
